



Campus of Care Opens in Qualicum Beach

Seniors on Vancouver Island now have increased access to housing and care services with the opening of the new 227-unit Gardens at Qualicum Beach campus of care.

The Gardens at Qualicum Beach provides a range of seniors' housing options including 39 condominiums, 62 independent living apartments, 30 assisted living suites and 96 residential care beds.



Qualicum Beach residents now have more options available in their community to support their long-term needs. These new residential care beds and assisted living units are part of a campus of care, a unique model that allows people to stay in the same location even as their care needs change over time.
