

Regional District of Nanaimo's expansion reaches LEED Gold

The Nanaimo Regional Transit Office has undergone a major facelift. The energy-efficient LEED certified office addition, site improvements and overall facility upgrades are complete.



The scope of the work included a 5000 sq.ft. expansion for the Regional District of Nanaimo's Administration Offices and 4000 sq.ft. addition to the Transportation Services (BC Transit) Building. The renovations and additions bring each building up to a LEED Gold status once certification is complete.

Eco-friendly features incorporated during construction on the administrative office and transit buildings include a green roof for the transit building and a water efficiency management system for both. Water is piped through a solar collector on each roof satisfying that building's hot water demands. The landscape plan saw extensive re-planting of native species where possible.

The \$4.4 million project designed by Neale Staniszki Doll Adams Architects was built by Windley Contracting. The project was completed January 2010.
